Students Entering 3rd Grade

Students entering 3rd grade will read a minimum of 3 books over the summer. Please select one (1) fiction, one (1) non-fiction, and one (1) adventure book. All books must be on grade level and about 90 pages long.

Students should choose one (1) book and create a publicity poster (similar to those outside of movie theaters) using descriptive words and a picture of the main character or of some event in the book. Please be original and do not copy the cover of the book! The poster should make everyone want to read your book!

Write a brief Book Review of the other two selections using the appropriate form provided (see below).

Projects are due the first day of school, August 18, and will count as the first test grade of the first quarter. Ten points will be deducted from the grade for every day late.

I have found that a little bit of work each day makes this project very manageable. Have fun!
